10-11 God's Identity Revealed in the Book of Esther with Wendy Cohen

God isn't mentioned in the Book of Esther.
But look at the dates. Look at the names. His signature is everywhere.
Come discover such a wealth of hidden secrets you will leave in awe.

Wendy Cohen is a Spirit-celebrating, Yeshua loving, God fearing, Jewish worshiper of the Living God. As a poet and author, she is passionate about sharing the wonder of God's Story with fellow-travelers in Yeshua's Grace. This workshop will give you a peek into the hidden prophetic and declaratory significance of one of those stories, a living parable for such a time as this.

11-12 Discussion: Why should the Church care about her Hebraic roots?

Led by four individuals and/or couples, this will be a dynamic and intimate time for you to explore your thoughts and beliefs about the Hebraic roots of the Christian faith. What has been concealed from the church through our ignorance of our Hebraic roots? What does the LORD want to reveal now through our increasing knowledge?

We will have four leaders facilitating the discussion.
(Afterwards, at lunch, you can continue the conversation.)

Greg Groppe, new to Messianic Judaism, has recently realized how much beauty and significance were withheld from him because of the Church's ignorance of its roots. A highly gifted teacher and a man of profound insights, he will stimulate you into new and/or deeper thought.

Kristi Palmer began exploring the Hebrew roots of her faith almost by accident. In 2009, she contacted a ministry to inquire about a healing service. There, she discovered the origins of the Hebraic holidays, how the Christian church had separated from its roots, and more. This sparked a 14-year journey into the Torah and the Hebrew language that has deepened her faith and awakened her to a new understanding of covenant.

Fred and Janeal Scott joined the Messianic movement in the fall of 2012. God's call on their lives was immediate and unmistakable as He opened

their eyes to the Hebraic understanding of the Scriptures and filled them with a passionate love for the Jewish people and Eretz Yisrael (the land of Israel). Their passion underscores their desire to see Jewish people come to faith in their Jewish Messiah, Yeshua (Jesus). Fred and Janeal serve as Shammashim (deacon couple) in their Messianic synagogue.

Wendy Cohen is a Jewish believer in Messiah Yeshua. Her walk with Him has always been marked, influenced, and magnified by her relationship to YHWH, as described throughout Scripture. God's marking of days and dates resonates deeply within her and informs her life. Come listen to her joy in her Savior through her King, through her Father.
